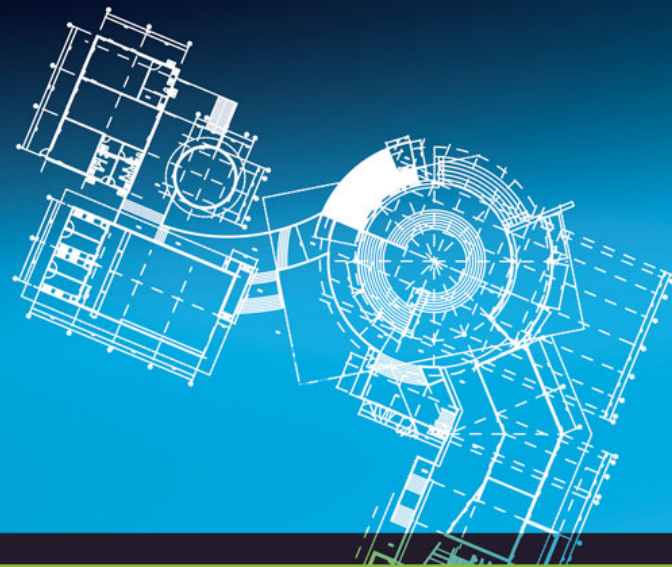

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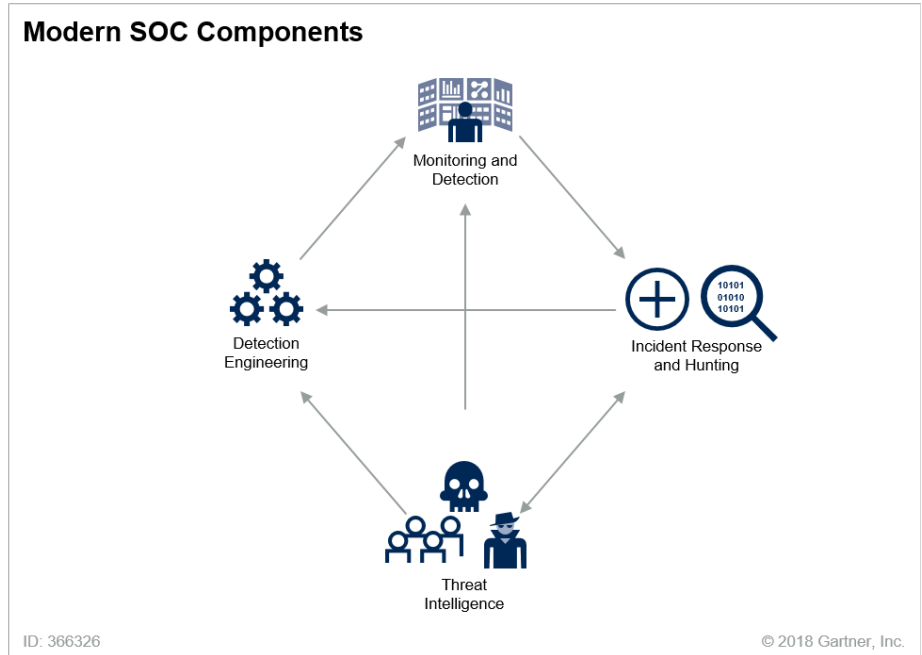


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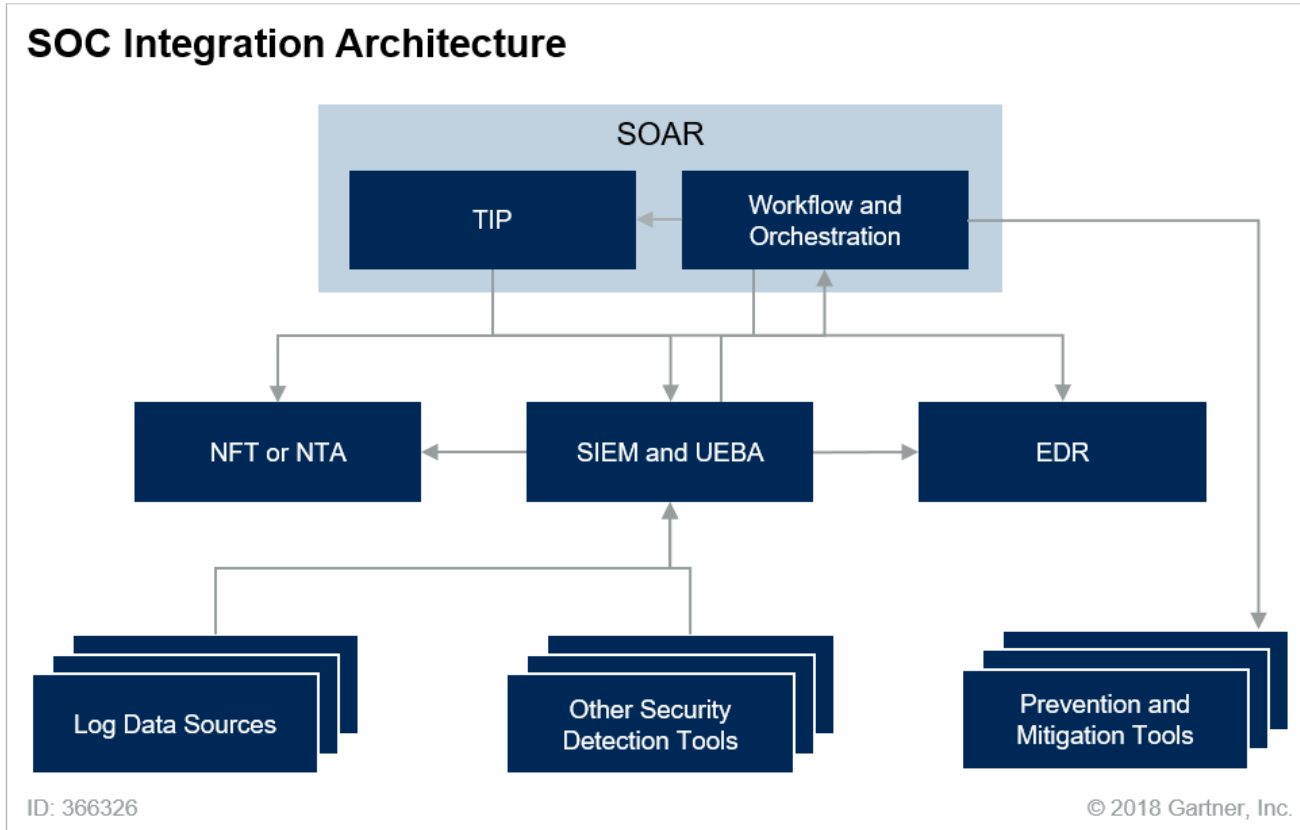


# By 2022, 50% of all SOC's will transform into modern SOC's with integrated IR, TI and threat hunting capabilities

- A **SOC (Security Operations Centre)** is defined as a team, often operating in round-the-clock shifts to provide 24/7 coverage, and a physical/virtual facility dedicated and organised to help predict, prevent, detect, assess and respond to security threats and incidents. However, the SOC does not always have to be a physical facility.
  - A network operations centre (NOC) is not a SOC. A NOC focuses on network device management and performance monitoring rather than detecting and responding to security incidents.
  - Using an MSS is not the same as having a SOC — although every managed security service provider (MSSP) will offer services from a single SOC, or often multiple SOC's. A managed service is a shared resource not solely dedicated to a single organisation or entity.
